The World Health Organization officially declared Coronavirus (COVID-19) a pandemic, as of this morning. Our Administrators, Board of Directors, and WCA leadership team are working together and we will provide daily updates to the current situation.

If you are sick, please do not come to school. Any parents, staff, students and visitors with symptoms of fever and/or respiratory infection or who have a travel history within the last 14 days to an area identified by the CDC as Level 3 Travel Health Notice, will not be admitted to the school. We seek parents' full cooperation in self-identifying by not coming to school if you are sick or have traveled to one of these areas. Travel restriction information. Advice from the LACDPH changed today to stay home for 72 hours after a fever, not the 24 hours recommended yesterday.

Any decision to close schools will be made upon advisory from the LA County Office of Education and the LA County Department of Public Health and in conjunction with local and state agencies, including LAUSD. We are monitoring this closely and will keep you immediately informed. If it becomes necessary to close our schools' parents will be notified by robocall and email.

WISH is fortunate to have web-based instructional options available if we are required to make changes to our instruction due to closure or cancellation. The teachers have been preparing to serve children should off-campus instruction be required.

WISH continues to spread awareness and education and prevention of transmission by: Continuing to use a robust, regular cleaning and disinfection schedule for

frequently touched surfaces. Student desks and chairs are being cleaned with disinfectant daily, the staff is cleaning doorknobs regularly, and the restroom fixtures are also being cleaned during the scheduled restroom check-in times.

Encouraging universal handwashing through posters and class announcements. Ordering additional handwashing and sanitizing supplies.

Teachers are taking the time to review health and safety precautions with the kids

that include proper hand-washing and cough covering.
