COMMUNITY SERVICE REFLECTIVE ESSAY

Each student will submit a typed (double-spaced) essay on his/her community service. The essay should be 500-750 words and should be written using the MLA style formatting. The student essay is due on 4/30/2021.

As you write your essay you will need to answer the following questions:

Paragraph One: What is philanthropy/community service?

Paragraph Two: What was your role in your community service project? In other words, what kinds of tasks did you complete?

Paragraph Three: How did your community service build a bridge between you and the community which you served? Include both joys and frustrations and give examples of acting for the common good.

Paragraph Four: What would you recommend to the next student who might follow you in the same assignment?

Paragraph Five: Why is it important to be involved in a project like this?

Paragraph Six: Who was the most memorable person OR what was the most memorable event of your community service?
