SCHOOL DESCRIPTION

WISH Academy High School (WAHS), a comprehensive, fully-inclusive, charter high school is a public four-year secondary school in the city of Los Angeles and neighborhood of Westchester. Our gifted, general education, and special education students all receive inclusive instruction and differentiated supports and services using our co-teaching model. WISH Academy is located approximately 3 miles northwest of Los Angeles International Airport (LAX). We opened in August 2017 and are currently in our fifth year. This senior class is our third graduating senior class. WAHS is accredited by the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC).

RESPONSE TO COVID


In mid-March 2020, our school switched to distance learning. We used the Big Blue Button on Canvas. The school day was shortened, and scholars finished by 1pm instead of 3:55pm. Scholars could not get grades of 0 during this time, and their final grades could not be lower than what they were on March 12th. If a scholar's work brought up their grade, it would count towards their total grade. If the scholar's work was of poor quality, it would not count toward the final grade. Letter grades were issued at the end of the Spring semester. For Fall 2020, we continued distance learning with letter grades. However, all work counted towards scholars' final grades. We had hybrid learning beginning April 2021, and we returned to in-person learning in Fall 2021. Some students opted for independent study during the 2021-2022 school year, and a few are doing independent study for the Fall 2022 semester as well. For the Spring 2023 semester, we will be fully in-person, and independent study will not be an option. During the 2020-2021 school year, students were unable to take the SAT or ACT as tests were continuously canceled throughout the year.



GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Five units are awarded to each class that is successfully completed at the semester. Classes are taught in a block schedule. Advisory classes are pass/fail and worth one unit each semester. Most classes are yearlong; few changes are made at the semester. Semester grades and credits are assigned in January and June.

GRADING POLICY

Students are ranked by weighted cumulative GPA according to their grade level. The high school transcript is a weighted 9-12 academic grade point average. One extra point is given for each 10th-12th grade Honors, Advanced Placement, or Dual Enrollment course with a C-grade or higher.
