Middle school is the time when you put all of your study, social, and organizational skills to work! You will be traveling between classrooms for different content areas with different teachers, so these supplies will help you stay organized and prepare you for success!

General School Supplies

- ★ One Pencil Pouch (with a clear window) to fit the following supplies:
 - One package of no. 2 pencils (10 pack) - sharpened and ready for class
 - Personal pencil sharpener (with a chamber and lid)
 - Erasers (the white erasers work best)
 - Red and green ballpoint ink pens (correcting and editing work)
 - Blue and black ink pens (everyday writing)
 - Two Highlighters
 - One pair of student scissors
 - Correction tape (no correction fluid)
- ★ Eight 2-pocket Folders (Any Colors)
- ★ **Headphones with a Cord (no bluetooth!)**
- ★ **Charged laptop! (Please make sure that students have a charging plan for their BYOD or School-Issue Device)**

Optional Supplies:

- One box of colored pencils (optional)
- Colored markers (NO SHARPIE OR PERMANENT MARKERS) (optional or recommended)
- Sticky Notes (optional)
